Construction at our North Gate on 44th Avenue

I am sure you have noticed all the activity on 44th Avenue at the North Gate exit to Rosedale. The contractor will be performing heavy construction activities at the intersection of Solutions Lane, 44th Avenue E., and Highland Links Street (northern entrance to the Rosedale community) for several weeks.

Work will involve digging, drilling, grading, filling, compaction, and curb-work in preparation for a new signalized intersection.
